

Recommended Browser Settings for Moodle 1.9.2

Moodle is compatible with most modern Web browsers including Internet Explorer 6 and 7, Firefox 2 and 3, and Safari (Mac). For best results, we recommend either Firefox 3 or Safari.

For Moodle to function correctly, it is recommended that the following requirements are met: 1) Pop-ups are enabled, 2) Cookies are enabled, and 3) Java is installed, up-to-date and enabled.

To detect whether you have Java or need an update, please go to <http://www.java.com>. By clicking "Free Java Download" on the page, the site will also help you determine if you have the latest version of Java installed.
